

Clay Making classes with Melissa Mead

***note: clay/glaze/firing a piece costs \$7/kg. The item is weighed after the final firing.**

Items to bring If you are a beginner:

- For beginners I recommend a \$2 Shop beginners kit that sells for about \$12. It has a wooden rib and “knife”, a wire tool, trimming tool, sponge and usually a version of a loop tool. Similar kits are sold at CCG for \$25. You can purchase online and the kit is delivered within a few days.
- Needle point
- an apron and towel.



Recommended for Intermediate/Advanced:

Bring what you have but suggestions are:

- Ribbon tools, wooden and rubber kidney
- Stainless steel rib
- A selection of wooden modelling tools
- Wire cutter
- Needle point
- Sponge and a sponge on a stick
- Palette knife and a small putty or small kitchen type knives
- Rolling pin, items from kitchen or workshop tools to shape mark and pattern clay
- Or useful rubber/wooden or natural pattern stamps, plus clay cutting and shaping tools
